
Dear Mr. Halle:

Code of Maryland Regulations ("COMAR") 08.05.10.04.D requires the Department, as part of its review of applications for surface mining permits, to determine the accuracy of drawings submitted pursuant to Natural Resources Article § 7-6A-19(b)-(d) (now Environment Article § 15-822(b)-(d)) and COMAR 08.05.10.03D. Representatives of the Department have discussed with you the inconsistencies between the plans submitted to the Department and those submitted to the County. These plans show two different locations for the access road to the Site.

The Department would like these inconsistencies resolved before rendering its final decision. We would like this resolved in order to be certain that COMAR 08.05.10.04D(1) is satisfied and because it is our understanding that the special exception for the property must be rescinded if the use of the property deviates from the County-approved site plan. See § 11-112(a)(2) of the County zoning code.

Please take any steps necessary to reconcile the plans on file with the County with those submitted to the Department. Once the plans are consistent, the Department will proceed with its decision.
