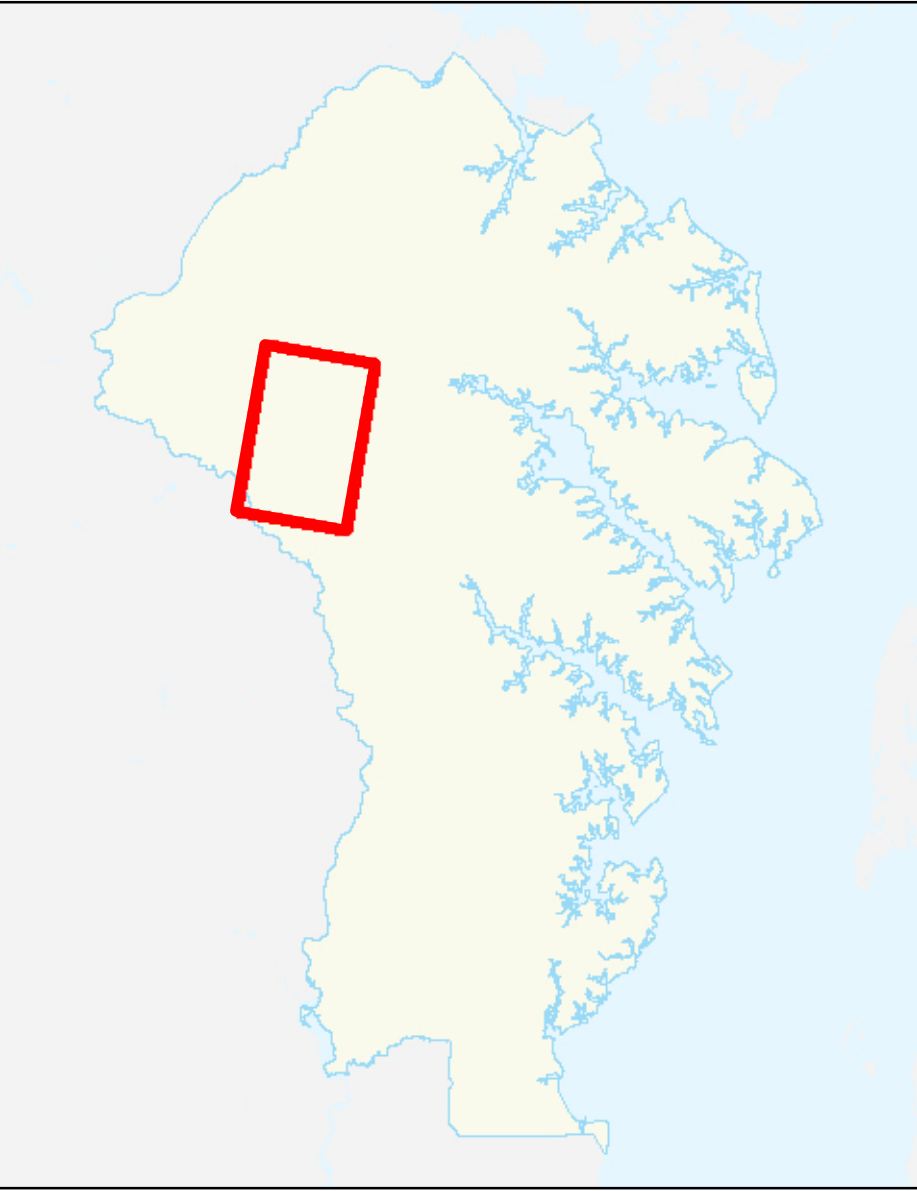


WB & A TRAIL

WB&A Trail

The WB&A Trail is a planned 9 mile paved recreational trail from Odenton to the Patuxent River on the abandoned Washington, Baltimore and Annapolis Railroad right of way. In addition to the regional implications of this trail, it is also a critical component of the East Coast Greenway and the American Discovery Trail.

Phase 1 (2.27 mi.)
-- Odenton Road to Strawberry Lake Way
Open and operational.

Phase 2 (1.68 mi.)
-- Strawberry Lake Way to Conway Road
Open and operational.

Phase 3 (1.71 mi.)
-- Conway Road to Patuxent River
Constructed by the developer of the
Two Rivers subdivision as part of
the subdivision infrastructure.

Phase 4 (3.32 mi., 1.44 mi. existing)
-- Strawberry Lake Way to Annapolis Road
Existing from Piney Orchard Park/ES to
Waugh Chapel Road.

Phase 5 (0.05 mi.)
-- Bridge over Patuxent River
Connects to the WB&A Trail in Prince
George's County. AA and PG Counties
working together wit the State to fund,
design, and build.
