Dear Mr. Fleischman:

On Jan. 14, 2022, the Maryland Department of the Environment (MDE) received the revised Phase III Engineering Plans and Specification Report (the "Phase III Report"), consisting of Volumes 1 of 3 through 3 of 3, for the proposed Chesapeake Terrace Rubble Landfill. The revised Phase III Report was prepared and submitted on your behalf by Advanced Geoservices.

MDE has completed its review and hereby approves the Phase III Report. The Phase III Report is now considered complete and meets the minimum requirements of the Code of Maryland Regulations (COMAR) 26.04.07.16. As a condition of obtaining and maintaining a Refuse Disposal Permit, you must provide to MDE evidence of a surety bond for the Chesapeake Terrace Rubble Landfill, covering the fill areas as well as monitoring wells, sediment and erosion control structures, access roads, landfill scale house, and other structures related to activities for the landfill, as required under §9-211(c) of the Environment Article, Annotated Code of Maryland. You must also provide MDE with proof of a deed amendment pertaining to the landfill that stipulates upon closeout of the operation, construction or excavation on the site may not begin without first obtaining written authorization from MDE. We have enclosed a copy of the deed amendment form for your use. In addition to evidence of a surety bond, please return the recorded and notarized deed along with a map showing all parcel numbers for the landfill.
